- Understand that Jesus is the fulfillment of God's law and apply that truth to our lives.
- To realize that our heart attitudes are just as important as our actions and He uses murder, adultery, poor integrity and hate as examples.
- To be people who demonstrate generosity to a broken world.
- To pray well and to pray often.

- The necessity of laying up treasure in heaven by serving in His kingdom.
