To be sanctified means to be or for God's purposes.
Two Steps of Sanctification 1 (Initial) Sanctification which takes place at the point of our salvation. And remember that those who do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them do not belong to him at all. Romans 8:9b NLT
2 Sanctification which occurs at some point after our salvation when we understand the necessity of surrendering to Jesus' will. Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me. If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it." Matthew 16:24-25 NLT
