Key Verses of the Day

1. The Good Shepherd is your **PROVIDER**.

The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. Psalm 23:1 ESV

So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. Matthew 6:31-33 NLT

2. The Good Shepherd wants you to live in **HIS PEACE**.

He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. Psalm 23:2 ESV

Saul replied, "You are not able to go out against this Philistine and fight him; you are only a boy, and he has been a fighting man from his youth." But David said to Saul, "Your servant has been keeping his father's sheep. When a lion or a bear came and carried off a sheep from the flock, I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth. When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it. 1 Samuel 17:33-35 NIV

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father's hand. John 10:27-29 NLT

4. The Good Shepherd is **EVER PRESENT** in your life.

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Psalm 23:4-5 ESV

DON'T MISS THIS!

- We <u>WILL</u> walk through valleys in life.
- We need <u>NOT</u> fear in the valley.
- For God is **ALWAYS** present with us.
